Job Description: The role will coordinate the work of MAISA's regional coaching and the implementation and scale up the literacy intensives, along with supporting the professional learning for other ELPL projects. The individual will collaborate and communicate with MAISA project directors and coordinators, along with key stakeholders to support the deliverables of the 35a(7) work.

- Support the development and facilitation of the coaching events within the 35(a) assurances.
- Support all regional coach leads with quarterly meetings
- Plan, organize, and support coach coordinator meetings (regional leads will support the planning in their region)
- Plan and organize intensive institutes (1.0 and 2.0)
- Collect regular input and interact with project stakeholders and participants
- Collaborate with the MAISA Early Literacy team to ensure coherence
- Ability to develop/design professional learning materials/modules
- Present to large groups in ways that are engaging and thoughtful

- Minimum of 5 years experience teaching;
- Experience using adult learning principles to facilitate professional learning
- Understanding of the role of ISDs and their relationship with local school districts
- Demonstrated application of project management/leadership skills
