#### **PROGRESS:**

MiSEN is proud to support the 12c Consolidation Connectivity Grant, aimed at connecting entities identified through the connectivity feasibility study. This grant enables MiSEN to sustain its operations and assist eligible educational institutions in joining the State Education Network (SEN). Through SEN, participants gain access to regional and statewide collaboration, high-speed transport and internet services, and robust cybersecurity protections, including DDoS mitigation.

# January 2025:

- Finalized Agreement between Shiawassee RESD and Michigan Statewide Educational Network (MiSEN) for Services
  - ➤ The agreement with Shiawassee RESD was reviewed through Thrun and Broadband Legal and presented to the SRESD board
- Development of the consideration rubric to prioritize entity projects was reviewed with MiSEN Advisory and MiCH Council to assist in determining the order of support
- Developed draft annual account ledger for SRESD
- Reviewed with MAISA Contract and additional project support to establish the Project Management Role
- Initial notification and interest forms were emailed to every district and ISD on the identified entities list from the feasibility study

# February 2025:

- Entity review meetings with all ISDs to ensure data validation for the status of identified entities
- ❖ 35 responses representing 65 locations have been collected
- Requesting updates to the GISD contracts to include grant fiscal support
- MOU detailing services for grant support to Entities being developed





- Chart of Accounts for the grant implemented in Schools Open Fiscal Management
- First invoice for Grant Funds submitted to SRESD for Operational support
- Working with E-rate Central to request that USAC acknowledge the Connectivity Grant funds as State Matching funds

## March 2025:

- Utilized Operational and E-rate funds to support current operational invoices, including Internet Access, Transport, and E-rate consulting services.
